OUR MISSION:

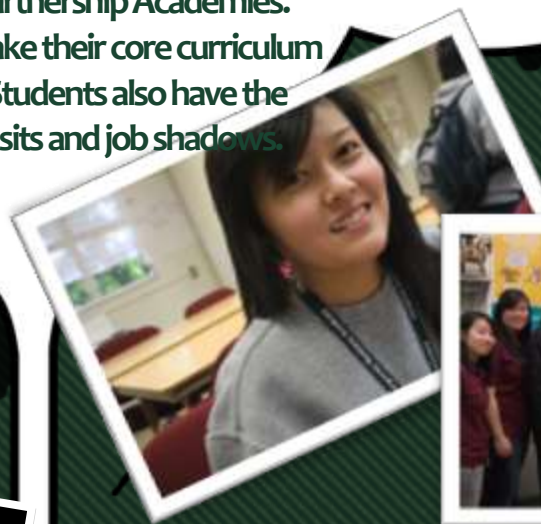

Extra-Curricular Opportunities with JCBA

VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance)

JCBA students have the opportunity to learn how to prepare tax forms through the VITA program. Our students learn to utilize IRS software and gain certification by the IRS for tax form preparation. Students then volunteer their time preparing tax forms for fellow students, staff and the community under the supervision of staff members and IRS employees.

Student Store:

Our students gain valuable business experience by operating the Hiram W. Johnson High School student store. This includes ordering merchandise, stocking, and sales. Students gain the skills needed for operating a small business.

SAGE (Students for the Advancement of Global Entrepreneurship)

This program has students create a business plan and then put their plan into operation. They take their results to a national competition where they compete against other high school students from other parts of the country. This year's competition will be in San Francisco.
